8th March celebration by peasant's women

Anjamna Mozareen Punjab has decided to celebrate the 8th March at all the villages of Military Farms Okara, Kulayan Military Estate Okara, Military Farms Renalkhurd and Army Welfare Trust Depalpur. The meetings at village level will take place on 8th March. Peasant women leaders alongside with their male leaders will speak on the occasion. They will speak about the history of 8th March and the importance of the day for fighting women rights. Women peasant leaders will demand an equal property rights for women at the meetings.

This is the first time that Anjamna Mozareen Punjab will celebrate the day at all 38 villages of different Public Farms. A campaign for land rights at these Farms are going on since the year 2000.
