## **Nawaz Sharif deported: Another dictatorial measure by Musharaf regime**

The deportation of Mian Nawaz Sharif to Saudi Arabia is another manifestation of dictatorial measures carried out by Musharaf regime. Musharaf regime had no constitutional or legal right to throw a person out of country against his will.
