Organisations supporting the Burma Day on 6<sup>th</sup> October include Amnesty International, the International Federation of Human Rights' Leagues (FIDH, Paris), Human Rights Watch, the Burma Campaign UK, the US Campaign for Burma, AVAAZ, the ITUC and many others throughout the world.

**Action is expected to take place on all continents**, at 12:00 (noon) local time, on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> October, in the following countries: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Denmark, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Ireland, Japan, Luxemburg, Malaysia, Mongolia, New Zealand, the Netherlands,

Norway, South Africa, Korea (ROK), Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Taiwan, USA and the United Kingdom. Other countries are still likely to join.
